



The Hastings Thrives Partnership – headline successes 2015-16

Impact on pupil outcomes and quality of teaching:

Some very encouraging signs EYFS and KS1. These are the areas of our greatest investment as we have committed to addressing underachievement from the very start of the child's education.

Early Years

- GLD 75.8% 2016 (up 3.4%) **above National Average of 69.4 %** and in line with other East Sussex outcomes.
- APS 36.3% (up 0.5%) **above National Average of 34.5%.**

KS1

- Phonics **up 2.5 %** but still below National and East Sussex averages. (81%) but **gap now -13.7%**
- KS1 reading 74% working at expected level. **In line with National (74.1%)** and slightly below East Sussex (75.6%). However, the gap of 16.9% is less than the East Sussex gap of 17.4% (National figure not available).
- KS1 reading GDS 26.2% In line with East Sussex but **above NAT Av 23.6%**
- KS1 73.8 % EXE **above Nat Av of 72.6%** Gap 19.6% No National but E Sx 18.6%

Maths

- KS1 EXS disadvantaged pupils **slightly above 60.9%** with East Sussex 60.4%
- Successes in individual schools taking part in the work included improved outcomes and progress for the targeted group of pupils and improvements in the quality of maths teaching

Thrive

- All schools now have thrive practitioners
- Thrive practitioner network meetings established
- We have 2 trainers that can be used beyond Hastings bringing in income to the partnership.
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Impact on raising the profile of the work:

- Charity status in the pipeline
- Hugely successful song competition held at the White Rock Theatre
- Hugely successful carnival event in June 2016 raising the profile of the work across the town
- The partnership now has full support from the local MP and from Hastings BC.
- Plans are currently being implemented to extend raising the profile of our work.
